Before the official start of our Saudi Trip, early arriving alumni were hosted to a delightful dinner at the ALULA ZAY in Jeddah. As the day wound, a dinner beneath the resplendent full moon unfolded at Maraya, the world's largest mirrored building. 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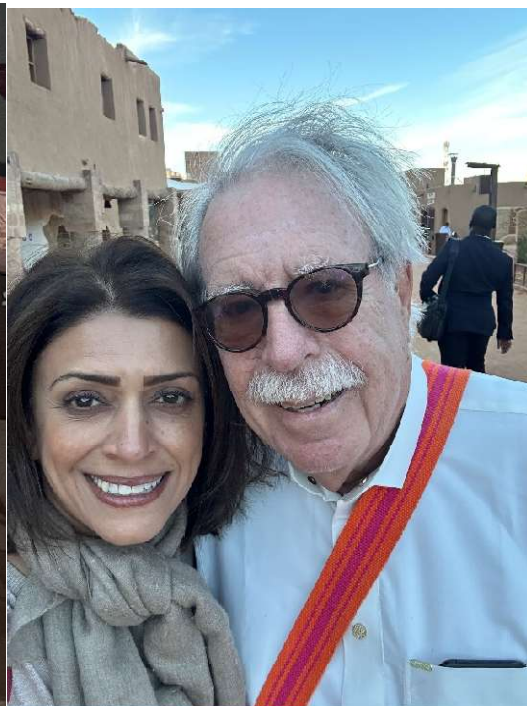

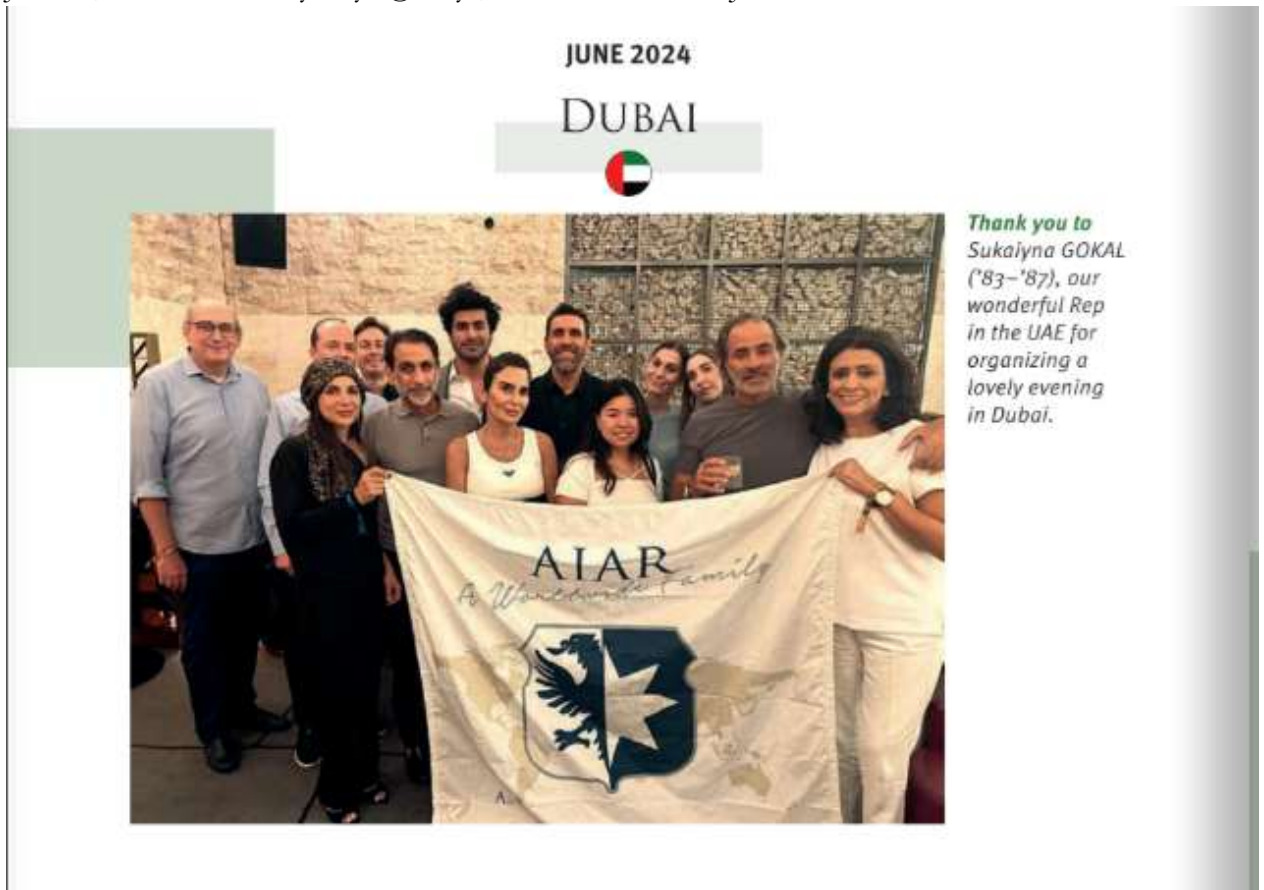

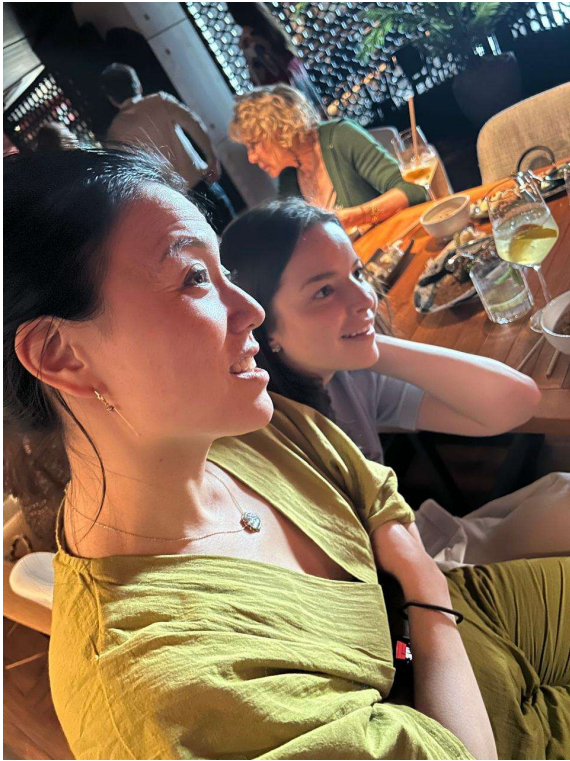

50TH ANNIVERSARY OF WOMEN AT LE ROSEY

On the 8th of June 2018, the AIAR and Le Rosey organized a special event to mark the celebration of the 50th Anniversary of Women at Le Rosey, in the prestigious Rosey Concert Hall. All students, teachers, Anciens and Anciennes were invited, and the participation at the event, as well as through live stream, was impressive.



Anne GUDIN

The Women's Talk was introduced by Madame Anne GUDIN, directrice and educator of Le Rosey for over 35 years. She spoke about her professional experience in education by exposing different types of female leadership in diverse historical contexts, history being her specialty and passion.



The event was moderated by successful journalist Annika PERGAMENT ('85-'87), senior business anchor for the NY's morning news which is broadcasted across the United States. During her career, Annika covered all major news including such events as the attack on the Twin Towers and, more recently, the Wall Street financial crisis.

Justine KASA VUBU ('67-'71), one of the very first girls who inaugurated the "Section Feminine", is a Congolese politician who was candidate in 2006 to the presidency of the Democratic Republic of Congo. She introduced the topic of women in her country and the difficult conditions they still face in African society, to have access to education and equal rights. Today, Justine is the President elected to represent the diaspora of over a million Congolese nationals.

Tae ASHIDA ('80-'83) spoke about her 30 years working experience in the fashion industry, by illustrating how her company works and what is its impact on Japan's society.

Elena ZAFIROVA ('99-'03) is a dual qualified US/UK lawyer who practiced wealth management and tax law at Baker and McKenzie for over six years. She then joined the financial industry as a senior wealth management consultant at Lombard International Assurance where she worked for 3 years. Elena is passionate about empowering the next generation.

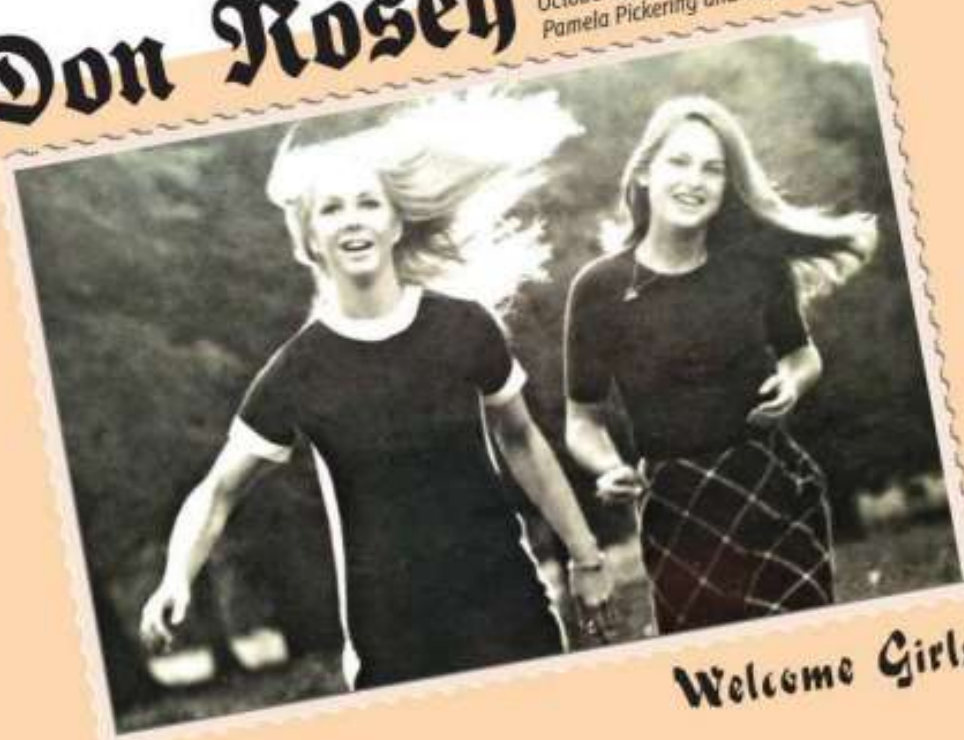
